## Why The Chosen?

Being chosen by Jesus has beautiful and far-reaching implications – although it says even more about the Chooser than those who are chosen. We are loved because He's love. We are saved because He's merciful. We belong to the family of God because He invites us, making the Bible and all its promises as true for us today as it was for God's chosen nation.

What does it actually mean to be Chosen?

To answer that question, we're going Old School – Testament that is – which leads us back to the New. Which always leads us directly to Jesus.

Join us for this 9-week journey in Life groups and on Sunday mornings as, accompanied by Season 1 of The Chosen television series about the life of Jesus, we connect to God's story for our lives.

## How will it work?

Each week will be tied into a particular episode of The Chosen. All you need to do is make sure you've watched the relevant episode before you arrive on the Sunday, watch online or go along to your Life Group.

## Then, on Sundays:

We'll explore the Old Testament context as we journey through Isaiah 43, always finishing by pointing to Jesus. There'll obviously be some references to the relevant episode, and we might even show a clip or two.

And then in your Life group:

You get to catch up and chat about what happened in that week's episode (set in the New Testament). You'll get to look through the eyes of the characters to explore who Jesus is in light of the Old Testament context, the events of the episode and your own experiences.

## Week beginning Sunday 30 January: You are called

#### Watch: Episode 1 - I have called you by name

But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine." Isaiah 43:1

#### Week beginning Sunday 6 February: You rest

#### Watch: Episode 2 - Shabbat

"When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame will not consume you." Isaiah 43:2

#### Week beginning Sunday 13 February: You are cherished

#### Watch: Episode 3 - Jesus loves the little children

"For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Saviour. I give Egypt as your ransom, Cush and Seba in exchange for you. Because you are precious in my eyes, and honoured, and I love you, I give men in return for you, peoples in exchange for your life." Isaiah 43:3-4

#### Week beginning Sunday 20 February: You change course

#### Watch: Episode 4 - The Rock on which it is built

"Fear not, for I am with you; I will bring your offspring from the east, and from the west I will gather you. I will say to the north, Give up, and to the south. Do not withhold; bring my sons from afar and my daughters from the end of the earth, everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made." Isaiah 43:5-7

#### Week beginning Sunday 27 February: You are a witness

#### Watch: Episode 5 - The wedding gift

"Bring out the people who are blind, yet have eyes, who are deaf, yet have ears! All the nations gather together, and the peoples assemble. Who among them can declare this, and show us the former things? Let them bring their witnesses to prove them right, and let them hear and say, it is true. 'You are my witnesses,' declares the Lord, 'and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe me and understand that I am he. Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me.'" Isaiah 43:8-10

## Week beginning Sunday 6 March: You are made new

#### Watch: Episode 6 - Indescribable compassion

"'I, I am the Lord, and besides me there is no Saviour. I declared and saved and proclaimed, when there was no strange god among you; and you are my witnesses,' declares the Lord, 'and I am God. And henceforth I am he; there is none who can deliver from my hand; I work, and who can turn it back?"" Isaiah 43:11-13

## Week beginning Sunday 13 March: You are established

#### Watch: Episode 7 - Invitations

"Thus, says the Lord, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: 'For your sake I send to Babylon and bring them all down as fugitives, even the Chaldeans, in the ships in which they rejoice. I am the Lord, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.'" Isaiah 43:13-15

## Week beginning Sunday 20 March: You are carried

#### Watch: Episode 8 - Invitations

"Thus says the Lord, who makes a way in the sea, a path in the mighty waters, who brings forth chariot and horse, army and warrior; they lie down, they cannot rise, they are extinguished, quenched like a wick: 'Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." Isaiah 43:16-19
