### our mission is God's mission

Our mission is to participate with God as He builds His kingdom here in Newport Pagnell.

This means remaining rooted in order to bear fruit.

Keeping our collective and individual eyes fixed on God, focusing on the spiritual growth of God's people in this community, which in turn will lead to more hearts that know him, and more hearts open to serve him.

As we continue to explore what it means to be God's people here...

- in the context of a post-pandemic, changing church
- with a community that is also changing significantly

...we have a growing sense that the Holy Spirit is leading us to step out in faith and share his love in new and exciting ways across our community and city. This will almost certainly be our focus for 2025.

As we prepare for this in 2024, we have already identified two areas we need to focus on.

# healthy vine fit-for-purpose trellis

The vine: our ministries (focused internally and externally); the living out of the Great Commission

The trellis: the resources – people, money, premises, systems – that support the growth of the vine.



Without a healthy vine, we are just an organisation.

Without an adequate trellis, the healthy growth of our vine is limited.

As we prepare for the next stage of growth, whatever that might look like, we know we must ensure our trellis is fit-for-purpose. However, our mission is vine-focused, so we have to find the right balance across these two areas, especially as we build towards 2025.

The status of our building project means that there will inevitably already be significant moments in 2024 when we place an emphasis on our financial resources and our premises.

Above this, however, we believe that in 2024, God is calling us to focus on releasing His people, to step up and then step out together.

### releasing God's people to bear fruit

released into rest

We are a busy church.

Whilst this can be a good thing, in a busy world with so many distractions, we are called to be counter cultural. We always want to be people who start by resting in the presence of God, recognising that He is the one who renews our strength. In 2024, this means we will:

- begin the year with 3 weeks of restoration
- explore what the Bible has to say about rest in a teaching series throughout September
- build greater support for those, especially in our leadership, to find healthy rhythms of work and rest
- released to use our God-given gifts

We are all called to use our God-given gifts to play our part in collective service. This is vital if we are to be the healthy and vibrant church that we are called to be.

In 2024, this means we will:

- explore our individual gifting in a special teaching and life-group series in May-June
- onboard at least 4 new elders, inc. a chair of trustees
- identify and equip up to 4 new Sunday service leads
- identify and equip a new Baseline lead
- review the roles and responsibilities of our staff teams

The Bible is full of examples of people being given opportunity and support to step into places that only God could truly equip them for. As we seek more of this for our own church family, in 2024 we will:

- further establish opportunities and mentoring for young people across worship bands, audio-visuals, and other areas.
- build greater awareness of opportunities for people to be involved in mission through NPBC and other organisations.

### released into deeper relationship

We know that ultimately, we can only be the people God calls us to be if we invest in an intimate, Spirit-filled relationship with Him. In 2024, this means we will:

- complete our journey through Matthew's gospel
- further build Wednesday as a weekly day of prayer for everyone in the church family
- continue our drive for everyone to find themselves a Life group, and the opportunity to journey in faith and life with a small group of followers.
- refresh Hungry for Worship

### released to give

We want to rediscover the beauty of radical, Jesus-like generosity, connecting us to heart of our generous God, and bringing both freedom and joy when we think about money. In 2024, this means we will:

- explore the theme of generosity in Life groups.
- provide opportunities for people to participate in a giving campaign to the building project in March/April.
- ask everyone to increase their monthly giving by 5-10% in the first quarter of the year.
